a pesar de (que) = in spite of (the fact that)  
aunque = although  
como = a, in as much as  
de lo contrario = otherwise  
de ninguna manera = by no means  
en cambio = on the other hand  
pero = but  
por al contrario = on the contrary  
sin embargo = however, nevertheless  
sino = but  
sino que = but rather
